Where Does Snow Go?

Autumn Two Topic

Personal, social and emotional development

This term we will learning about how special and unique we are just like snowflakes. We will work together through teamwork to build igloos and continue to build relationships with our friends.

Communication and language

Children will be learning to develop their speaking, listening, attention and understanding skills by playing different games. They will discuss the changes in the season and listen to a range of winter stories.

Physical Development

During this half term we will be exploring the large apparatus in P.E looking at ways of travelling around, under, and over it. If possible give your child opportunities to travel around, under, over and through balancing equipment. The children will develop their fine motor skills by using scissors, threading, pencil control and learning to do their zips.

Literacy

Children will enjoy listening to stories and participate in stories and rhymes.

Children will begin to tune into sounds by playing various games. Children will experience a variety of materials when mark making from pens, chalks, paints, foam and gloop.

Maths

Children will, this half term, be looking at patterns to sort winter wear, match pairs of gloves and make repeating patterns with scarves. Children will have lots of opportunities to practise their counting skills by counting snowballs and matching the correct number of



Understanding the world

Children will be exploring what happens to snow and ice when it gets warm. We will be learning about winter weather, animals and their habitats.

Expressive arts and design

Children will be using junk modelling to make igloos, creating winter scene pictures and exploring different textures. Children will be painting with cold colours and explore colour mixing with ice paints. Children will also be exploring the ice cave role-play area and igloo.
